- be a resident of Sugar Grove, Illinois
- be a current library volunteer, Sugar Grove Corn Boil volunteer or other Sugar Grove 501(c)3 volunteer
- be a senior in high school or enrolled in a college
- have maintained at least a 2.0 GPA throughout his/her final two years in high school.
- be accepted to (or currently enrolled) an accredited college/university or technical school to which the scholarship will be applied and plan to apply the scholarship to the upcoming school year.
